Theater Gajes

In the last week of April, Theater Gajes worked hard to complete "Don Quixote"

so that this could be presented on the evening of Koninginnedag in Diepenheim. Famous Diepenheimers would participate on the Roller-skating rink opposite the 't Stedeke School. Unfortunately, due to the events at Palace 't Loo in Apeldoorn the show had to be canceled.

We are now together looking for a new date to re-schedule the show" according to Alda Assink on behalf of Kunsten op Straat.

Location Theater project in Oldenzaal

The official opening of the festival season in the province of Overijssel will be on Sunday evening, May 31st (Whitsun), in three cities at same time. At 22:00 the fires will be lit in Zwolle, Deventer and Oldenzaal.

In Oldenzaal the English group **Walk the Plank** will present their show "*Le Jardin Flambé*" in the Park Vondellaan.

During half an hour, the three actors will bring a fire garden to life. The audience can enjoy a beautiful installation of gas driven trees, fire flowers, and pyrotechnical effects accompanied by music. **Walk the Plank** began in 1991 and has settled in the northern England university city of Salford.
